Elective courses are divided into two categories as Departmental Electives and NonDepartmental Electives. You may find the rules and a summative table pertaining to elective courses below:

## Important Notes concerning Departmental Electives:

- According to Politics 2015 curriculum, the student must take 13 (thirteen) elective courses. At least 6 (six) of them must be Departmental Elective with PSI code.
- It is possible to take more than six Departmental Elective courses with PSI code.


## Important Notes concerning Non-Departmental Electives:

- 2 (two) of the Non-Departmental Electives must be courses with 5 (five) ECTS credits. These courses can be taken from all departments in The Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences, or from Psychology, Translation and Interpreting Studies, English Language and Literature in The Faculty of Arts and Sciences. It is recommended to consult academic advisors or the faculty members teaching the course.
- The remaining 5 (five) courses belong to the group of the courses with 3 (three) ECTS credits. Language courses, courses with CEC code, fine arts and sports courses (THEA, PES, MUS) are included. At most 2 (two) of them can be courses with THEA, PES or MUS codes.
- There is no precondition for language courses.
- It is possible to take Departmental Elective courses with PSI code instead of NonDepartmental Electives.


## The summary of the distribution of 13 elective courses is below:
